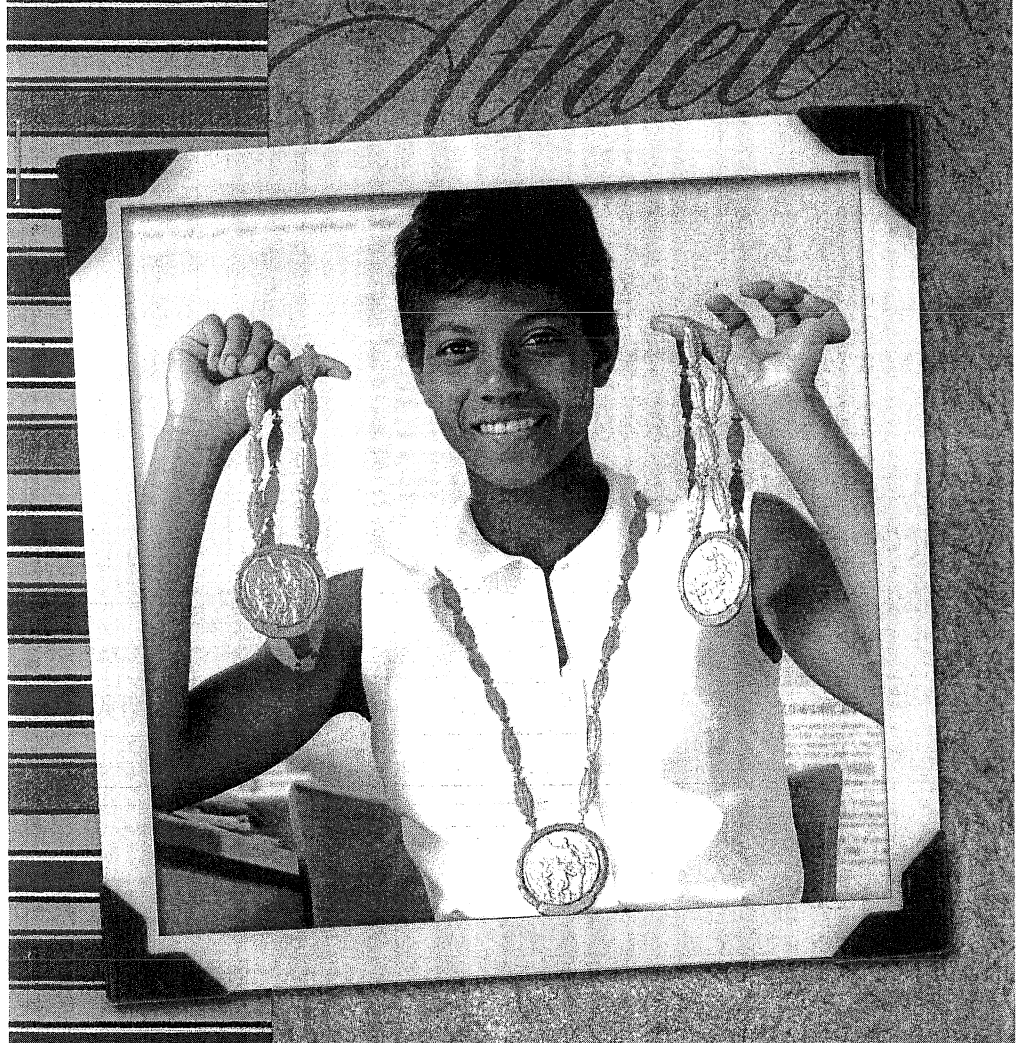

From the twentieth of 22 children, Wilma Rudolph was a sickly child. She had polio at an early age, which left her crippled. With faith, determination and the help of her family, she overcame it. A track coach discovered Wilma when she was on high school. She qualified for a college scholarship. She participated in the 1956 Olympics, but her triumph came in the 1960 Olympics in Rome. Running on a sprained ankle, she became the first American woman to win gold medals in track and field in the Olympics. Among many other honors and awards, she was invited by Billy Graham to the Baptist Christian Athletes in Japan in 1963. After retiring from competition she became a teacher and track coach. To this day, she is remembered as one of the fastest women in track. She died at age 54 of brain cancer.

After receipt of your login info please go back and login using your login name and temporary pass code. (Note: log in using all the temporary pass code characters as you see them or cut and paste). You will be prompted to change your password after successful login.

After you have successfully entered into the Access ACS database go to "my giving history", there is a tab that has your *PDF Tax Statement for 2010*.
