

In 1978, Maurice accepted the call to preach the gospel and received his license at Bethel Church of God in Christ, under the leadership of Pastor Robert Redell Langston. He enrolled in the Charles Harrison Mason Bible College in East Orange, New Jersey and later Manhattan Bible Institute in New York, where he received a Teacher's Certificate in Theology.

Since relocating to Virginia, he has furthered his education at the Fredericksburg Bible Institute, in Fredericksburg, Virginia earning his Associate, Bachelor, and Master degrees in Theology. After relocating to Virginia he joined the Tower of Deliverance Church Of God In Christ under the leadership of Elder James Lewis Moore, Sr. He was later assigned as the Administrative Assistant to an extension of the Tower of Deliverance COGIC located in Blackstone, Virginia, where he and his family served faithfully for one year.

Through much prayer and fasting he was led by the Lord to start a ministry in Richmond, Virginia. He founded Future Church which grew from a Bible Study conducted in a home. He was ordained as an Elder and appointed as Pastor of Future Church Of Christ (Holiness) USA by the late Bishop Eugene Brown, Sr. He was appointed as Interim Bishop of the Eastern Diocese on October 1, 2007, and was consecrated and appointed Bishop and presiding officer of the Eastern Diocese on July 27, 2008. He served as National Evangelist of COCHUSA and Southern District Chairman of the Eastern Diocese before his appointment to the office of Bishop.

He now serves as Chairman of the National Church Evangelism and Mission Board COCHUSA. Bishop Nicholson married Orelia Walton and they have two children, Shawn and Jennifer, two grandchildren and a daughter-in-law.


