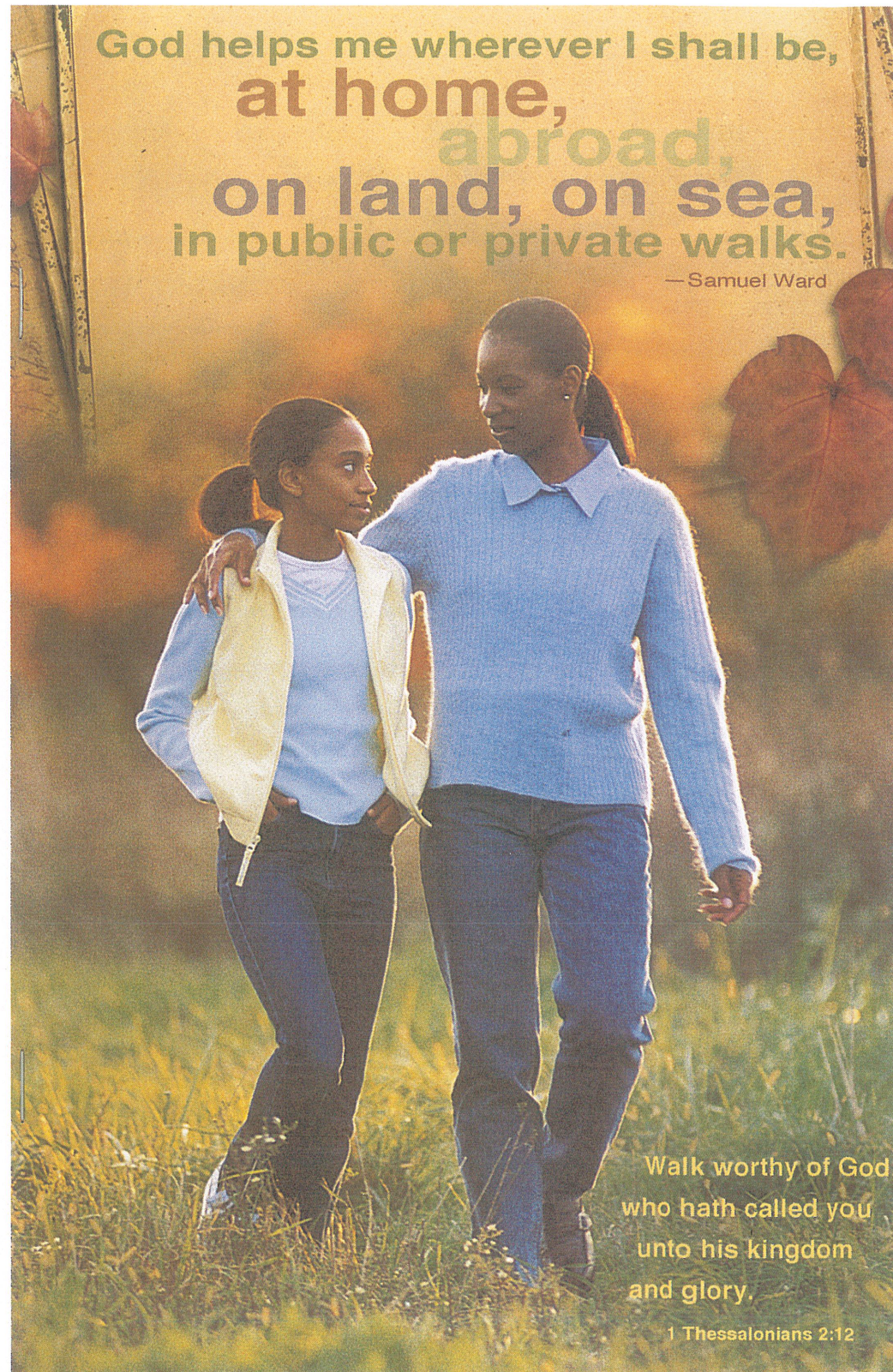

**What are the issues with diabetes during the winter months?**

Cold months can bring: more colds and flu; Changes in people's diet and exercise plans; Changes in blood sugar; More stress. **How can I manage my diabetes in the winter?**

## October is Breast Cancer

**Awareness Month...**an annual campaign to increase awareness of the disease. While most people are aware of breast cancer, many forget to take the steps to have a plan to detect the disease in its early stages and encourage others to do the same.

- One in eight women will be diagnosed with breast cancer in their lifetime. (Each year it is estimated that over 220,000 women in the United States will be diagnosed.)
- Breast cancer is the most commonly diagnosed and the second leading cause of death among women.(More than 40,000 will die.)
- Although breast cancer in men is rare, an estimated 2,150 men will be diagnosed with breast cancer and approximately 410 will die each year.

The best way to fight breast cancer is to have a plan that helps you detect the disease in its early stages. Create your Early Detection Plan to receive reminders to do breast self-exams, and schedule your clinical breast exams and mammograms based on your age and health history.

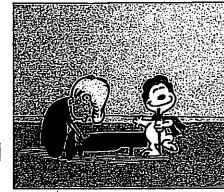
### OCTOBER IS DOMESTIC VIOLENCE MONTH

#### WHAT IS DOMESTIC VIOLENCE?

- Domestic violence can be defined as a pattern of behavior in any relationship that is used to gain or maintain power and control over an intimate partner.
- Abuse can be physical, sexual, emotional, economic or psychological actions or threats of actions that influence another person. This includes any behaviors that frighten, intimidate, terrorize, manipulate, hurt, humiliate, blame, injure or wound someone.
- Domestic violence can happen to anyone of any race, age, sexual orientation, religion or gender. It can happen to couples who are married, living together or who are dating. Domestic violence affects people of all socioeconomic backgrounds and education levels.

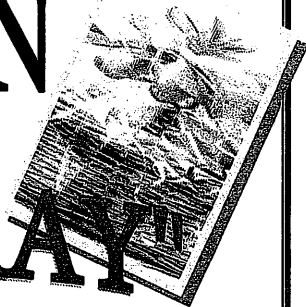

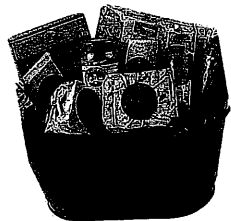
